








MONTANA AREA COMPARISON




GEOGRAPHIC CENTER OF POPULATION: CENSUS 2000




MONTANA COUNTY POPULATION DENSITY: CENSUS 2000




MONTANA COUNTY POPULATION DENSITY: 2008 ESTIMATES




MONTANA COUNTY PERCENT POPULATION CHANGE: 2007-2008 ESTIMATES




MONTANA COUNTY PERCENT POPULATION CHANGE: CENSUS 2000-2008 ESTIMATES




PERCENT OF POPULATION AGED 65 YEARS AND OLDER BY COUNTY: 2008 ESTIMATES




MONTANA POPULATION PROJECTIONS: PERCENT CHANGE IN 65 AND OLDER



TRIBAL LANDS IN MONTANA




PERCENT AMERICAN INDIAN POPULATION BY CENSUS TRACT: CENSUS 2000





PERCENT HISPANIC POPULATION BY CENSUS TRACT: CENSUS 2000





PERCENT OF RENTER HOUSEHOLDS WITH A COST BURDEN BY COUNTY: CENSUS 2000





PERCENT OF RENTER HOUSEHOLDS WITH A SEVERE COST BURDEN BY COUNTY: CENSUS 2000





PERCENT OF OWNER HOUSEHOLDS WITH A COST BURDEN BY COUNTY: CENSUS 2000





PERCENT OF OWNER HOUSEHOLDS WITH A SEVERE COST BURDEN BY COUNTY: CENSUS 2000






MEDIAN HOME VALUE BY COUNTY: CENSUS 2000


PERCENT OF POPULATION AGE 5 & OVER WITH A DISABILITY: CENSUS 2000




PERCENT OF POPULATION AGE 21 & OVER WITH A DISABILITY: CENSUS 2000




POPULATION AGE 21 & OVER WITH A DISABILITY: CENSUS 2000




**COUNTY OF RESIDENCE OF HIV/AIDS CASES DIAGNOSED IN MONTANA
 1985-2008 (N=575)**




**COUNTIES WITH HIGH POPULATION GROWTH: INCORPORATED VS. UNINCORPORATED:
