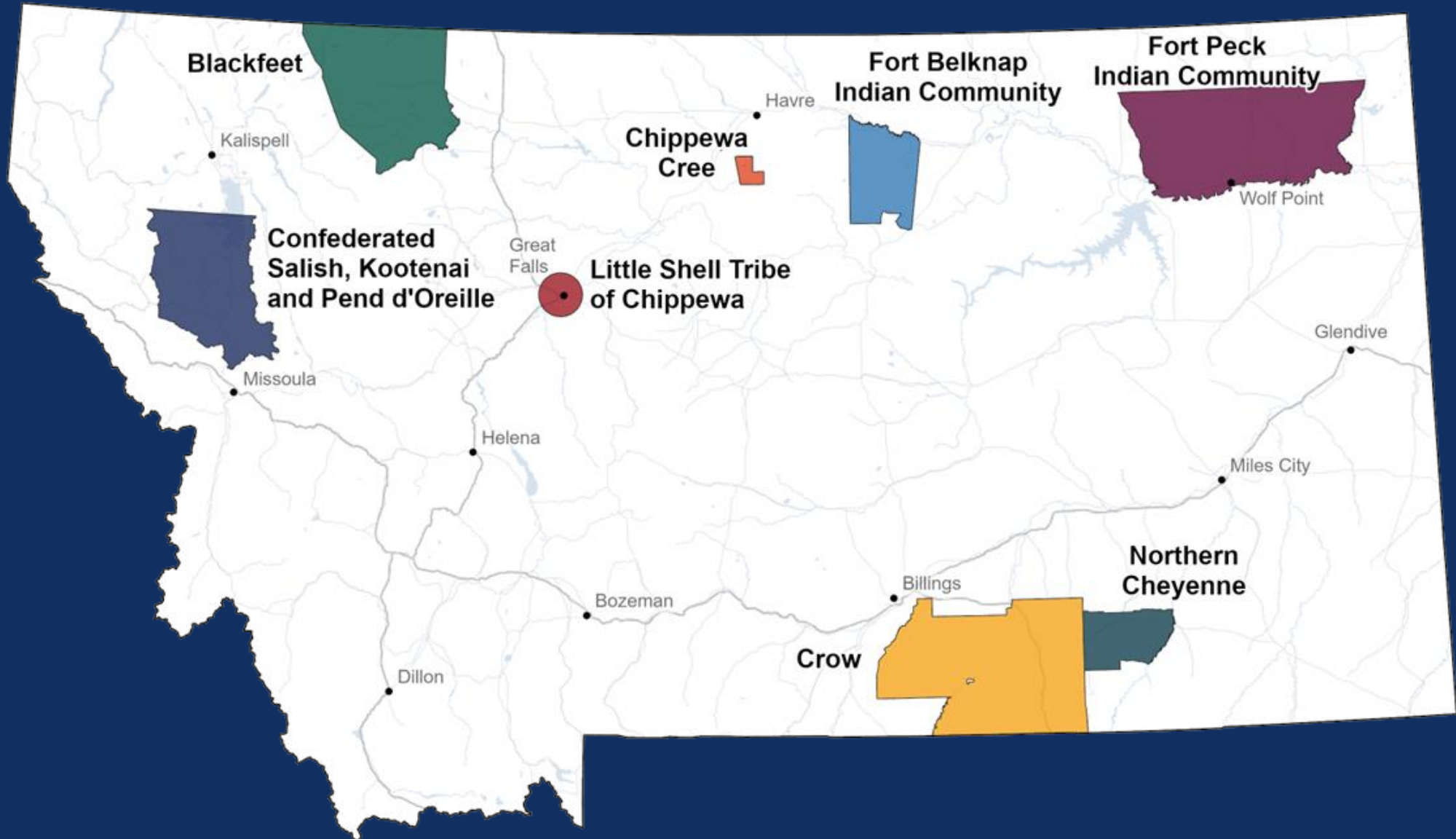

# Montana Indian Country Regions



# Confederated Salish, Kootenai and Pend d'Oreille of Flathead

- Western Montana: Polson, Pablo, Arlee and Elmo
- Best time to visit: May-October
- Small shops and eateries
- Lake recreation, vacation rentals and boat charters
- Kwataqnuq Resort and Casino, Bison Range and Three Chiefs Cultural Center
- Powwow celebrations in July, rodeos and the Cherry Festival

# Blackfeet Nation

- Northwest Montana: East Glacier and Browning
- Best time to visit: June-September
- Hiking and photography
- East entrance to Glacier National Park, rental cabins and tipis and vacation rentals
- Glacier Peaks Hotel and Casino, tribal campgrounds and tour businesses
- Powwow celebrations, Indian Relay races and rodeos in July

# Little Shell Tribe of Chippewa Indians

- Central Montana: Great Falls
- Best time to visit: May-October
- City location, hotels and restaurants
- First People's Buffalo Jump and Visitor's Center in Ulm
- Lewis and Clark Interpretive Center and Giant Springs State Park in Great Falls
- Powwow celebration in late August (Mount Royal, Great Falls)

# Chippewa Cree Tribe of Rocky Boy's

- Central Montana: Box Elder, Rocky Boy's Agency
- Best time to visit: May-October
- Rural location with limited services, hunting guides in winter months
- Skiing at Bear Paw Ski Mountain
- Northern Winz Casino, campgrounds, vacation rentals and hotels in Havre
- Powwow celebration and rodeo in early August

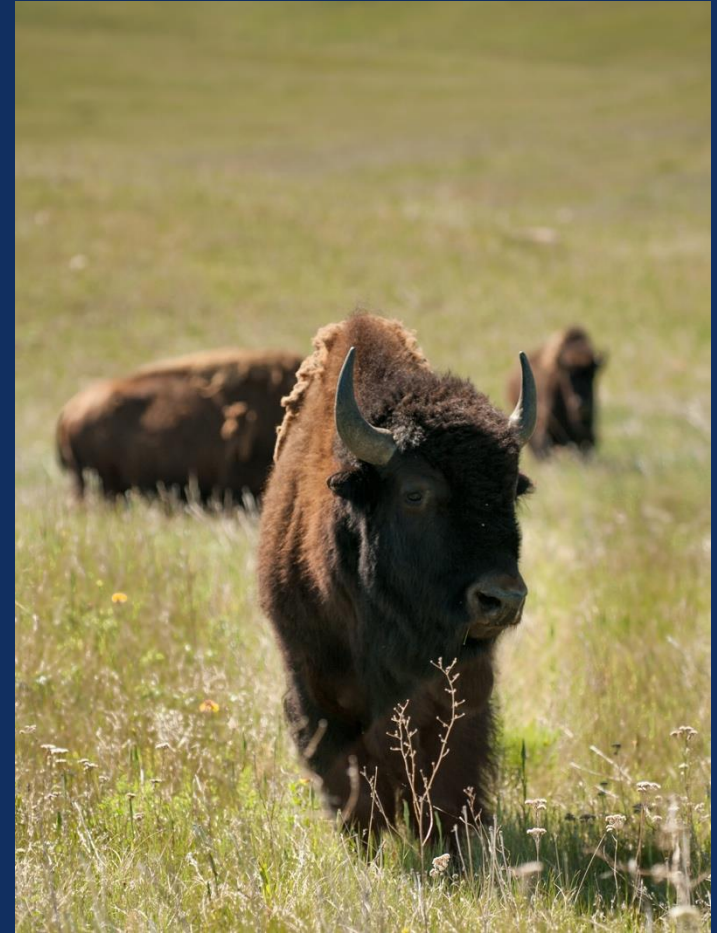


# Fort Belknap Indian Community

- North central Montana: Chinook, Harlem, Fort Belknap Agency, Hays, Lodgepole
- Best time to visit: May-September
- Rural location with limited services, some vacation rentals and small motels, hunting guides in winter months
- Bear Paw Battlefield in Chinook annual celebration in October, Marias River guided fly fishing, Mission Canyon, Aaniiih Nakoda Tours of bison herd, dark skies
- Powwow celebrations July, August and October

# Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes of Fort Peck

- Northeastern Montana: Frazer, Wolf Point, Poplar, Brockton and Fort Kipp
- Best time to visit: May-September
- Winter hunting or ice fishing with a guide, rural location with gas stations, restaurants and motels available
- Outdoor recreation on Fort Peck Lake, Charlie Russel Wildlife Refuge, bird watching, hiking, camping, swimming, boating, dark skies
- Powwow celebrations and rodeos in June and July

# Northern Cheyenne Tribe

- Southeastern Montana: Busby, Lame Deer and Ashland
- Best time to visit: May-September
- Historical sites and water recreation
- Medicine Rocks State Park, Warrior Grocery in Ashland and stores in Lame Deer
- Tongue River Reservoir offers camping and boating, pheasant hunting with guides
- Powwow celebrations “Wiping of Long Hair” June 25-26, early July rodeos

# Crow Tribe

- Southeastern Montana: Pryor, St. Xavier, Crow Agency, Garryowen, Wyola, Lodge Grass and Fort Smith
- Best time to visit: May-September
- Historical sites, rural location with limited services
- Apsaalooke Tours, Real Bird Reenactment of the Battle of Little Bighorn
- Pictography Cave State Park, Chief Plenty Coups State Park, Yellowtail Dam, Bighorn Canyon River, boat tours, Native-made arts, jewelry and small shops

# Indian Country Seasonal Activities

**Winter:** High school and college basketball games, skiing, ice fishing, hunting with native guides and outfitters, museums and storytelling lectures

**Spring:** High school and college basketball tournaments, fly fishing with native guides and outfitters, Warrior Racing cross country running competitions, state parks and Yellowstone



# Indian Country Seasonal Activities



**Summer:** Powwow celebrations, Indian Relay races and rodeos, historical sites, fly fishing, interpretive guides, tours, horseback rides, hiking, outdoor markets and Glacier National Park

**Fall:** Powwow celebrations, high school and college football, fly fishing or hunting with guides and outfitters, fall color road trips and Yellowstone and Glacier National Parks
