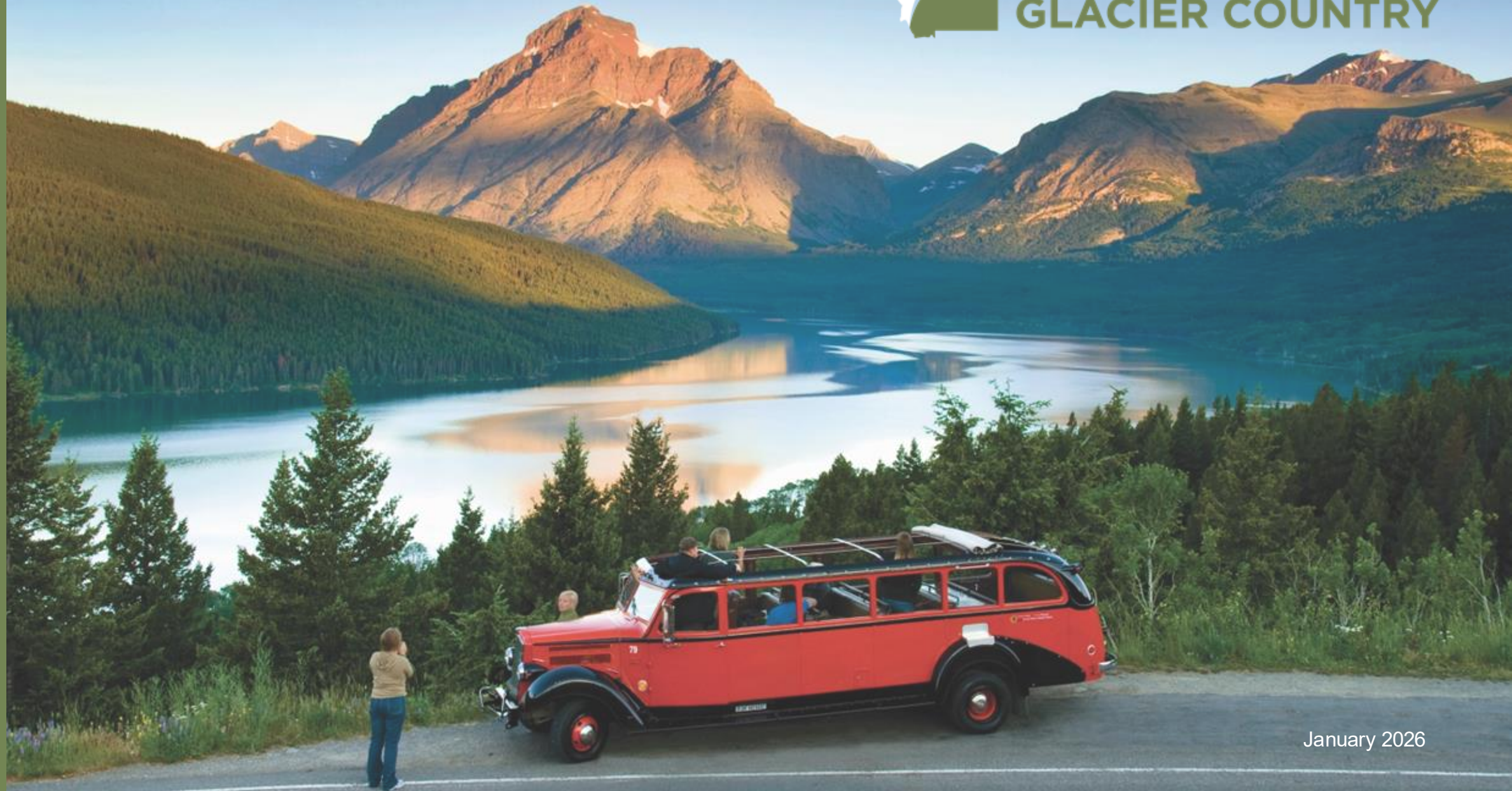


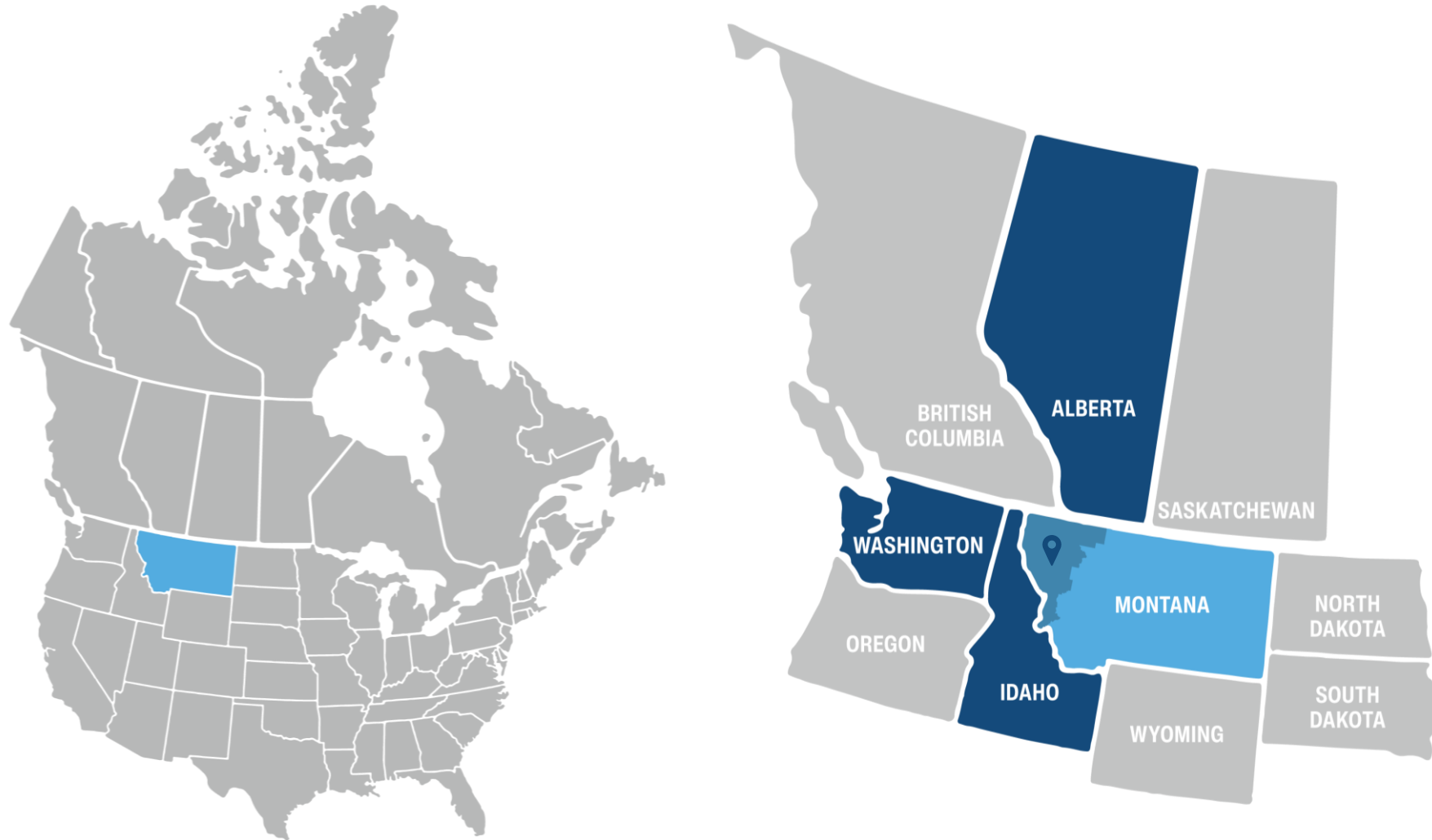

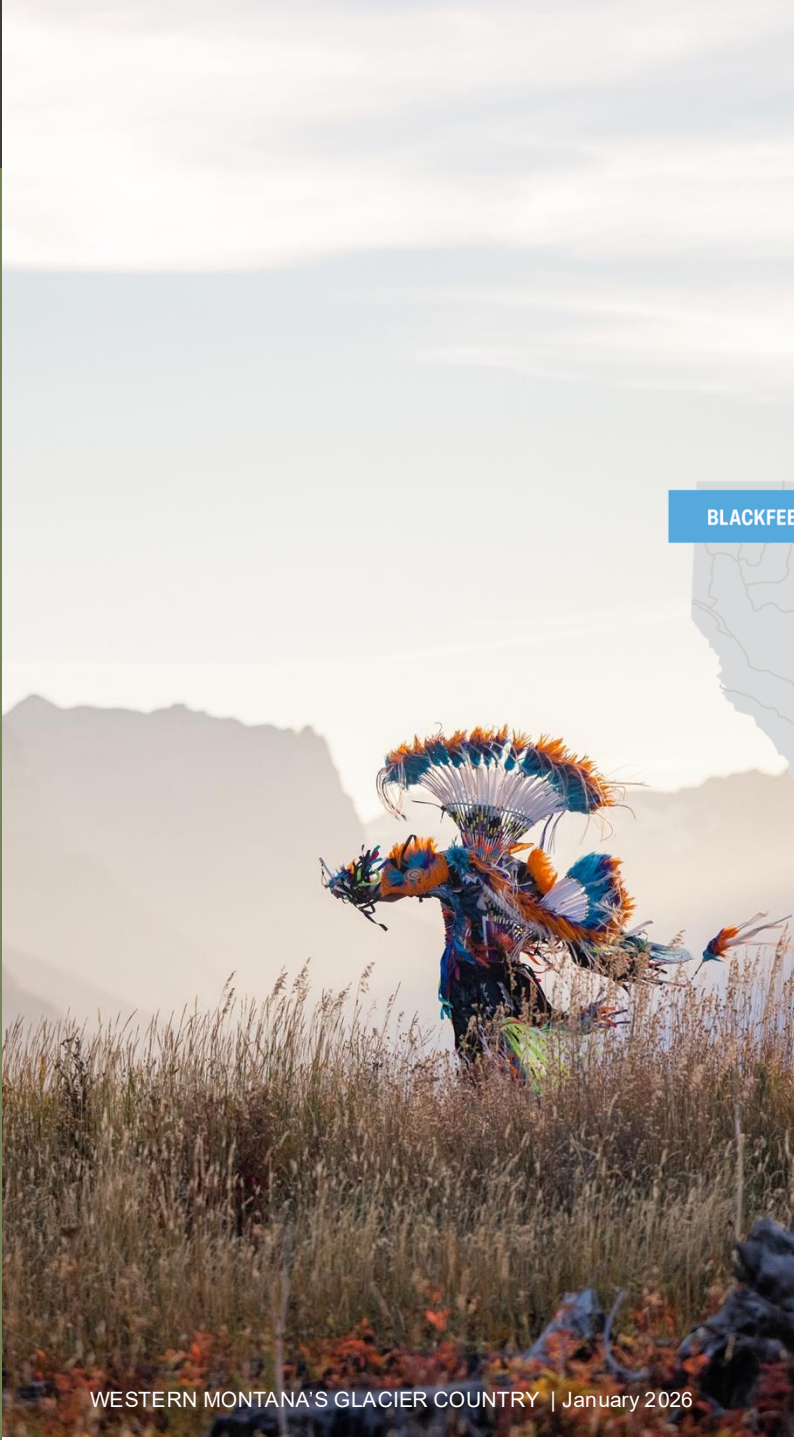


Glacier National Park. One million acres of beautiful landscapes, tall timber, towering mountains, rushing waterfalls and abundant wildlife

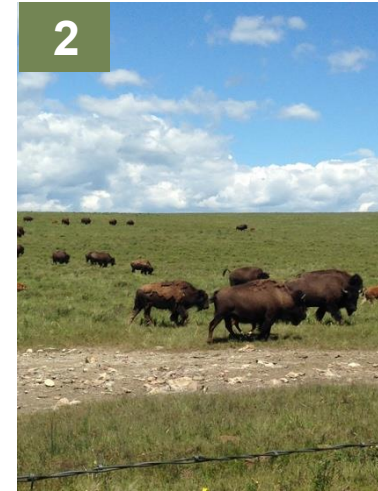
- Over 1,000 kilometers of hiking trails

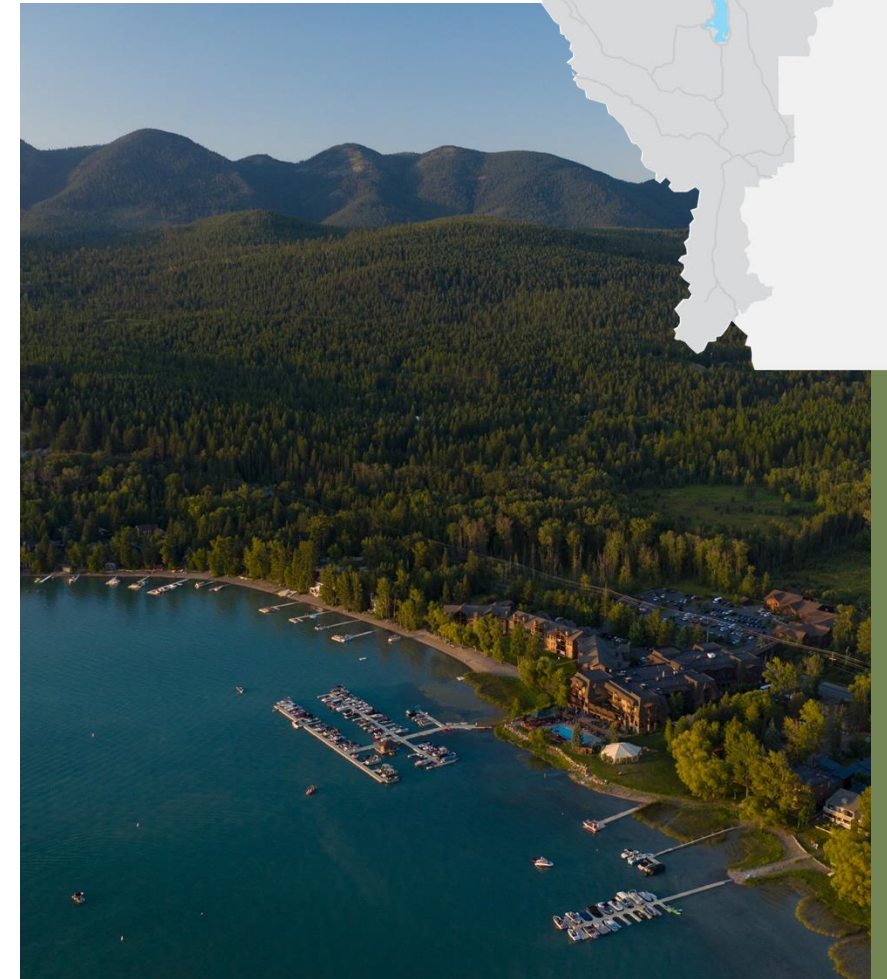
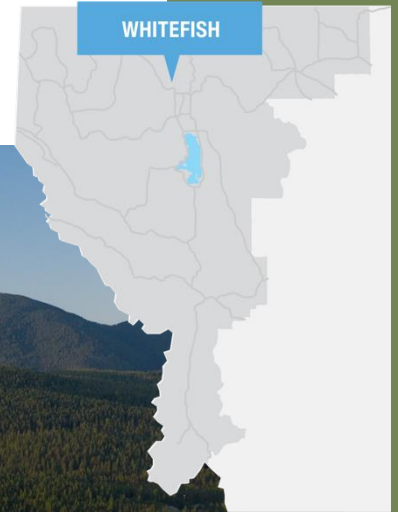

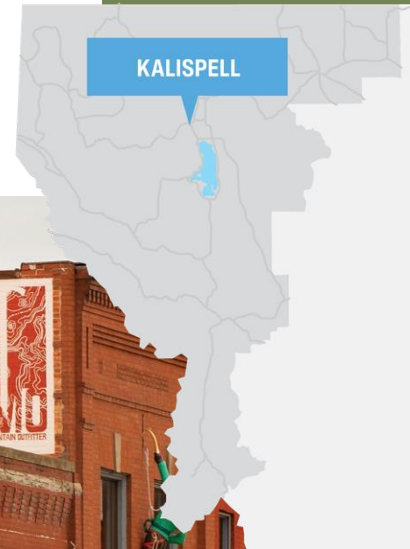

Kalispell is a great home base with easy access to Glacier National Park and Flathead Lake

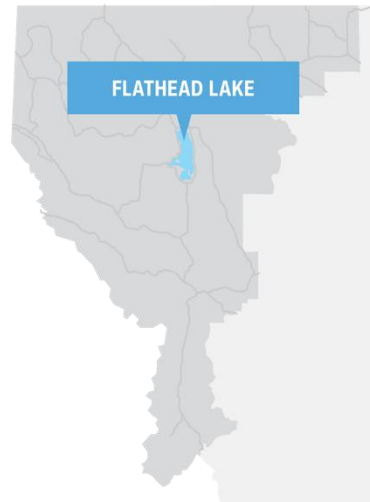


- 1 Kalispell is home to cultural museums: Conrad Mansion & NW Montana History Museum

Adventure awaits on Flathead Lake

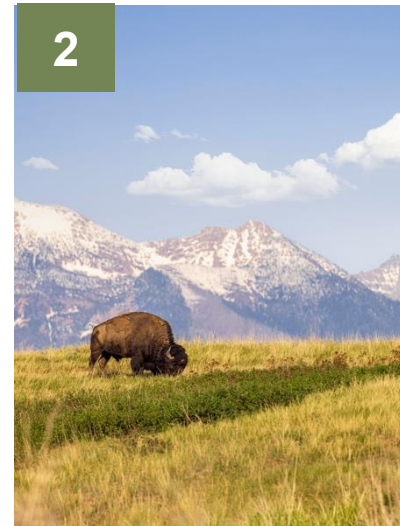
- Largest freshwater lake in the Western U.S. with seven state park access sites

- Communities of Bigfork, Lakeside, Somers and Polson have festivals and events year-round



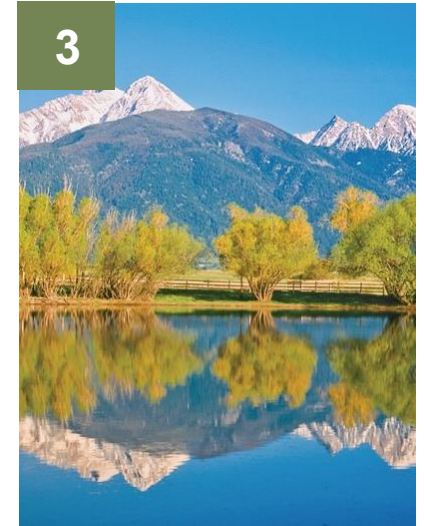
The Flathead Indian Reservation is home to the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes

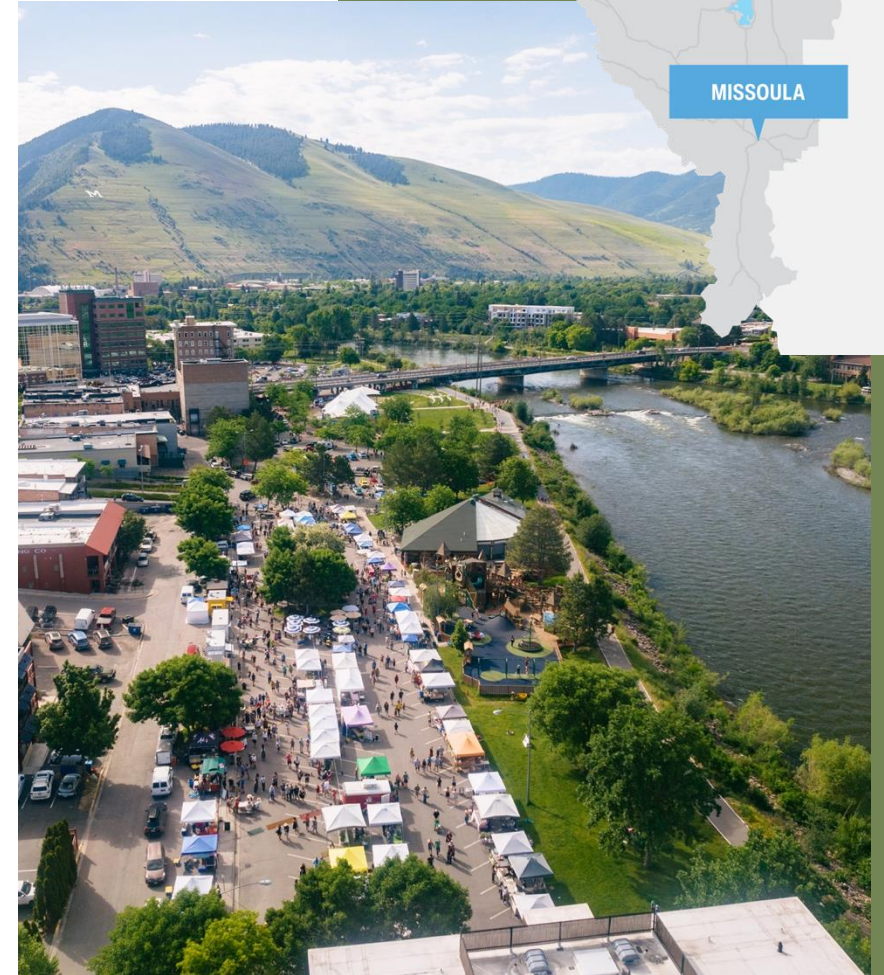
