- + Yellowstone National Park: Three of the park's five entrances are in Montana's Yellowstone Country.
  - + West Entrance in West Yellowstone
  - + North Entrance in Gardiner
  - + Northeast Entrance in Silver Gate and Cooke City
- + The Beartooth Highway is considered one of the most spectacular drives in the U.S. The highway spans from Red Lodge to Cooke City and is open Memorial Day to mid-October, weather depending.
