

Sample Request for Qualifications for Engineering Services

The (town, city or county) has received a f	ederal Community Development Block Grant
award in the amount of \$	by the Montana Department of

Contingent upon this award, the (town or city council or the county commission) is soliciting offerors of a statement of qualifications in response to this <u>request for qualifications for engineering services</u> to assist the (town, city or county) in both (a) designing and (b) supervising construction of this project in compliance with all applicable requirements under the current version of the Montana CDBG grant administration manual. Payment terms will be negotiated with the selected offeror. The fee for engineering services will be paid with CDBG funds.

The services to be provided will include:

- 1. Designing system improvements and construction engineering;
- Preparing the construction bid package in conformance with applicable CDBG
 requirements and supervising the bid advertising, tabulation and award process,
 including preparing the advertisements for bid solicitation, conducting the bid
 opening and issuing the notice to proceed;
- 3. Conducting the pre-construction conference;
- Field staking, onsite supervising of construction work and preparing inspection reports;
- 5. Reviewing and approving all contractor requests for payment and submitting approved requests to (town or city council or county commission) the governing



body;

- 6. Providing reproducible plan drawings to the (town or city council or county commission) upon project completion;
- 7. Conducting final inspection and testing;
- 8. Submitting certified as-built drawings to the appropriate federal or state agency; and
- 9. Preparing an operation and maintenance manual.

Responses should include:

- 1. The firm's legal name, address and telephone number;
- The principal(s) of the firm and their experience and qualifications;
- The experience and qualifications of the staff to be assigned to project;
- 4. A description of the firm's prior experience, including any similar projects (in particular those funded by CDBG), size of community, location, total construction cost and name of a local official knowledgeable regarding the firm's performance;
- A description of the firm's current work activities and how these would be coordinated with the project, as well as the firm's anticipated availability during the term of the project; and
- 6. The proposed work plan and schedule for activities to be performed.

Note: The evaluation factors listed below are examples.

Local officials should include those factors which they believe are appropriate to the work tasks to be involved, with relative weightings for each according to their priority, and must comply with section 18-8-201 to 212, MCA, especially section 18-8-204, MCA, concerning the minimum criteria that must be used in evaluating engineering firms responding to a request for qualification.

Respondents will be evaluated according to the following factors:

1. The qualifications of the professional personnel



	to be assigned to the project	%
2.	The consultant's capability to meet time and project budget requirements	%
3.	Location	%
4.	Present and projected workloads	%
5.	Related experience on similar projects	%
6.	Recent and current work for the entity issuing the RFQ	%

The selection of finalists to be interviewed will be based on an evaluation of the written responses. The award will be made to the most qualified offeror whose proposal is deemed most advantageous to the (town, city or county), all factors considered. Unsuccessful offerors will be notified as soon as possible.

Respondents may review the CDBG application, which includes a description of the proposed project including activities, budget, schedule and other pertinent information by visiting the (town, city or county) offices during regular office hours. This solicitation is being offered in accordance with federal and state statutes governing procurement of professional services. Accordingly, the (town or city council or county commission) reserves the right to negotiate an agreement based on fair and reasonable compensation for the scope of work and services proposed, as well as the right to reject any and all responses deemed unqualified, unsatisfactory or inappropriate.
